3	Section 5542 of title 5, United States Code, is
4	amended by adding at the end the following:
5	"(h)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
6	section, any hours worked by a firefighter under a quali-
7	fied trade-of-time arrangement shall be disregarded for
8	purposes of any determination relating to eligibility for,
9	or the amount of, any overtime pay under this section.
10	"(2) For purposes of this subsection—
11	"(A) the term 'qualified trade-of-time arrange-
12	ment' means an arrangement under which 2 fire-
13	fighters who are employed by the same agency
14	agree, solely at their option and with the approval
15	of their employing agency, to substitute for one an-
16	other during scheduled work hours in the perform-
17	ance of work in the same capacity; and
18	"(B) the term 'firefighter' means a firefighter
19	as defined by section 8331(21) or 8401(14).".
